Regulations

1. Carcase cattle to be NLIS compliant prior to delivery
2. Separate waybills, health papers and statutory declarations are required for carcase cattle. **(Do not include carcase cattle on hoof cattle section paperwork)**
3. **All cattle should be polled or completely dehorned**
4. Exhibitors are restricted to two nominations per class. The competition has to be limited to two chillers which is approx 160 sides. Should entries be excessive, the carcase committee reserves the right to conduct a draw for entry
5. To assist committee manage numbers, nominations should be sent to preferred agent by Friday 18th June 2010
6. All cattle must be mouthed and colour tagged, where possible, prior to the show. Mouthing can commence on Monday 24th May and should be finalised by Friday 18th June so that chiller space can be organised. **(Where other than committee members do the mouthing a signed certificate showing the date of mouthing should accompany the cattle).** If not, cattle will be mouthed on the slaughter floor
7. To constitute a competition, a minimum of three (3) entries shall be available for judging
8. Severely bruised carcasses will not be eligible for a prize, but will be appraised as for unbruised carcasses
9. All classes are eligible for special breed awards, provided notice of breed is supplied on the nomination form
10. Entry fees, and feeding and watering charges will be deducted from exhibitor's accounts by respective agents and paid to the Mackay and District A. P. & I. Association Inc., after the Show
11. The decision of stewards is final in all matters relating to the conduct of this section
