**Regulations**

1. Commercial patterns may be used as long as fabric choices and interpretation are that of the exhibitor
2. All machine quilting to be done by the entrant (except in Class 1)
3. All exhibits in Classes 1 to 3 must be fitted with a sleeve for hanging purposes
4. All exhibits in Class 4 must have a sleeve and rod or other method of wall attachment
5. Any entries determined not to fit these criteria will not be judged or displayed
6. Name and address of the exhibitor and the class for which the exhibit is entered must be shown on the back of the exhibit. It is recommended that all exhibits be delivered in a material bag or pillowcase with the exhibitor's details, as above, clearly attached
