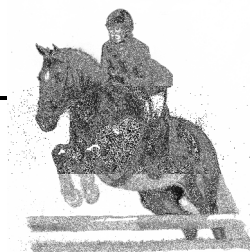

All entries must be lodged at the Ring Office during the show. A ticket system will operate.

GENERAL REGULATIONS:

1. Age of all horses to date from August 1
2. Horses must be free from heredity unsoundness in all classes except jumping and Sporting Events
3. Horses are to be paraded on the days, and at the times that the Stewards shall direct
4. Competitors, exhibitors, grooms or others in charge of exhibits must comply with directions given by Stewards. FAILURE TO COMPLY with directions may incur, at committee discretion, a fine, disqualification, and/or removal from the grounds
5. Exhibits wrongly entered shall be transferred to the correct class
6. All colts, stallions, two years and over, shall be led with a bit, and be under the complete control of the handler at all times
7. Stallions may compete in led-in classes and sporting events ONLY. All horses must be registered with their respective breed societies
8. All ponies and Galloways requiring to be measured should contact the chief Ring Steward
9. **MAIDEN:** A horse which has never won a first prize in any Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies - affiliated Show
10. **NOVICE:** A horse which has never won a Champion Hack in any Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies – affiliated Show

11. **YOUNG STOCK:** A horse 3 years of age and under. Youngstock only eligible to compete in their respective class
12. Any horse entered in Stud Classes **MUST** be registered in a Stud Book of their respective breed society and owners must be financial members of said society
13. On the occasion of the clash of events, the competitor must decide which event he/she intends to enter. The program will only be altered at the discretion of the Chief Ring Steward
14. **DISTRICT:** The district shall be anywhere within a 200 kilometre radius of Mackay. **DISTRICT PERSON:** Any person residing in the district continuously for no less than six (6) months immediately preceding the Show, provided that such person may leave the district to compete at affiliated Shows. The time qualification also applies to a 'District Horse' District Horse to be owned by a district person and ridden by a district person. (Refer to map of Region)
15. Approved safety helmets (3838 or better) **MUST** be worn by children under 17 years competing in all classes and showjumping events. It is strongly recommended that all competitors comply with this rule. The Association will not be responsible for any accident or injury that results from failure to wear approved safety helmets
16. All competitors/exhibitors are required to sign the official indemnity form, as a condition of acceptance of entries
17. Please note: E.F.A. members, sponsors special guests of the Association, and management committee -appointed stewards, only admitted to the ring during equestrian/showjumping competition
18. The Committee reserves the right to alter, amend or cancel any event in this schedule at any time, and without notice
19. Horses competing in hunter classes are eligible to compete in both open and hunter classes
20. **FOX HUNTER SERIES RULES:** Horses must be Maiden D grade registered EFA with a current performance card. Rider must be current EFA member and must be owner, part owner or lessee. Horses already to have won a foxhunter preliminary round are not eligibility. Horse's places 1st to 6th are eligible to compete in the final

THE DISTRICT AS DEFINED FOR DISTRICT HORSES AND RIDERS

As stated in General Regulation (17) the 200 kilometre radius which comprises "District" for District events is as illustrated above

COMPETITORS PASSES:

The ring office will be open between 4pm-5.30pm on Monday for the purpose of issuing armbands to allow competitors entry to the grounds

CAMPING AND PARKING:

NO CAMPING OR ELECTRIC FENCES ALLOWED IN THE RING

If you wish to camp at Sarina Showgrounds prior to Mackay Show PLEASE contact Sarina Show to arrange this. Ph 4956 1006 or 0418 737 096

Please note that very limited space is available for parking of vehicles and camping. All vehicles must park on the roadway outside the grounds. If at all possible you are requested to try and make alternate arrangement for parking horse floats and trucks

During the show vehicles are required to park on the closed section of Milton St. Only vehicles with an official sticker will be permitted to park

Any exhibitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showgrounds will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor

This is essential for the safety of all exhibitors and the general public and is a requirement of the Workplace Health and Safety Act of 1989. The Act imposes very severe penalties in the event of non-compliance with its provisions

Any exhibitor who fails to comply will not be allowed to exhibit at the Mackay Regional Show. Exhibitors should check all electrical equipment and leads before coming to the Showgrounds to avoid the occurrence of any difficulties
