Cattle must be delivered to the Show grounds no later than 12 noon Monday 21<sup>st</sup> June 2010

**JUDGING ORDER: Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2010**

Depending on numbers of Stud Cattle judging may be separated into three (3) separate divisions at the discretion of the Beef Cattle Committee

- **BRAHMANS**
- **TROPICAL BREEDS**
- **EUROPEAN BREEDS**

Rings and times will be determined on the day, depending on entries.

**REGULATIONS:**

1. Nominations without entry fees will not be accepted
2. Nose rings or clips must be used for all stud cattle over 12 months of age
3. All stock must be registered with the respective breed society
4. All entries must be named, and the breed stated on the entry form
5. The age of all entries shall be taken from 1<sup>st</sup> April
6. **A CALF BORN BEFORE 30 SEPTEMBER 2010 IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO BE SHOWN WITH ITS DAM**
7. Stock must be on the ground by 3.00pm Monday 21<sup>st</sup> June
8. Male stud cattle must be weighed by 12.00 noon Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> June. Led steer must also be weighed and mouthed prior to this time
9. Judging will commence at 8.00am Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> June, subject to amendment at the discretion of the Chief Steward
10. Any exhibitor failing to parade prize-winning animals may at the discretion of the Chief Steward be liable to forfeit all prize money and awards won

11. Stock must remain at the show grounds for the duration of the Show, unless special permission for prior removal is granted by the Chief Steward
12. Purchase of feed, feeding and watering of animals is the responsibility of the exhibitor
13. Stalls must be cleaned and refuse placed in bins
14. Championships will be awarded for all breeds exhibited at the discretion of the Judge
15. No drug, hormone or tranquilliser shall be administered to any animal exhibit, except under the specific direction of the Association's Veterinary Surgeon who shall advise the stewards if, in his/her opinion such drug, hormone or tranquilliser is likely to have any effect upon the animal, which would be material to its chances of being awarded a prize. In such cases, the stewards may debar the animal from competing. A steward may at any time direct the Association's Veterinary Surgeon to take a sample of blood, saliva or urine from an exhibit for testing
16. No dogs allowed in the Stud Cattle exhibit shed
17. All cattle must carry NLIS identification

**Insurance**

In the event of a potential claim resulting from damages involving livestock exhibited by the owner or his appointed agent, all exhibitors and/or their appointed representatives are reminded that no form of admission of liability is to be acknowledged. All complaints, together with a signed witness statement, must be reported directly to the Secretary/Manager, Mackay and District A.P. & I. Association Incorporated.

**Workplace Health & Safety**

Exhibitors taking electrical equipment on to the showgrounds must ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor. This is a requirement of the Workplace Health and Safety Act (1989) to enhance the safety of exhibitors and the public. The Act imposes severe penalties in the event of non-compliance. Any exhibitor who fails to comply will not be allowed to exhibit at the Mackay Regional Show. Exhibitors should check all electrical equipment and leads before coming to the show grounds to avoice the occurrence of any difficulties
